Dear Servant of the Lord:

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

THE SEVEN FIRST WORDS OF THE CHURCH

Philippians 4: 13 “I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.”

We are always interested in a baby’s first words. It usually takes a great deal of imagination and good bit of interpretation, but we try to determine those first words a baby speaks. They are even recorded in the baby book.

People are also interested in a person’s last words. They are supposed to give some kind of insight into that person and his/her personality. So we hang on to the last words.

The “seven last words of Christ” have been pulled out of the gospel accounts of the Crucifixion and the subject of music and unnumerable sermons.

Somewhere, sometime, someone identified the seven last words of the church as, “We never did it that way before.”

If those are the seven last words of the church, let me share with you the seven first words of the church, “I can do all things through Christ.”

These memorable words are found at the end of Paul’s little letter the Philippian Christians. Not only are they a good summary statement for Paul’s life, but they are also an adequate statement of the first words of the church, the words on which the church bases its life and ministry.

These seven first words of the church are positive.

Notice that Paul said “I can.”

How often and how easy it is to say, “I can’t.” A person may say, “I can’t control my

temper....cope with these jealous thoughts...stand my job....tithes...preach....do ministry....teach a Sunday School class...live a good life.” Yet these are things which some people obviously can do.

Instead of the negative “I can’t,” consider the positive “I can.” Many churches/ministries will major on what they do not have in the way of budget, programs or buildings. They ought, instead, to focus on what they do have in the way of people, possibilities and the power of the Holy Spirit.

These seven first words of the church suggest a pattern.

Paul said, “I can do all things.”

Against the tide of public opinion, endorsement of the “right” people, and established patterns, Paul set out to do all things. The list of his accomplishments is impressive.

When we think of all the things that are before us as Ministers of the Gospel, it seems staggering and overwhelming: world evangelization, world missions, world hunger, world peace. We can’t do all that!

But look at Paul’s pattern. We would go to one place and do one thing. Then he would move on to the next place.

This is the only pattern for us. Jesus, after all, came to one place, at one time, to one people. We cannot do it all, but we can do something.

In his book, *The Reluctant Witness*, Kenneth Chafin told of a seminary student who was very sensitive to the needs of other people. When he left school, he went to serve as pastor of a mission in a deprived community. He found people in need all around him. These he tried to help.

When the young minister and Chafin discussed the people he was trying to help, Chafin asked if the sheer number of people who had problems and needed help did not depress him. The young man seemed surprised by the question and answered “I’m so busy trying to help the people around me who need help that I don’t think too much about all the others. But I have the feeling that when I reach out to the persons in front of me and embrace their need, I have within my arms the whole world.”

These seven first words of the church affirm a presence.

How is any of this done? Through Christ and power of the Holy Spirit.

It is Christ and the Holy Spirit working through the individual that makes possible victorious

Christian living and effective Christian ministry.

Paul's whole life and ministry were explain by Christ and the Holy Spirit.

And it can be the only explanation of your life/ministry, too, if it is lived for Christ. There was an old French peasant in a village who visited the little church for an hour every morning before going to the fields and for an hour at the close of his labour. When the priest asked him what he did in those two hours each day he so punctually spent, he said, "I just look at Christ and He looks at me."

These seven first words of the church show power.

It is Christ who strengthens us. He is our power.

Power, energy, is a big problem in our day. There are searches for new sources, alternative sources of energy. The greatest source of power is Christ and the Holy Spirit.

These seven first words of the church send the church and its people out into the world to minister with power.

Servant of the Lord be encouraged in the Lord. St. Luke 10: 2 "Therefore said he unto them, the harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the Harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest."

VULNERABLE SCREENING

Recent changes by Federal authorities are increasing the time required to complete certain police information checks for persons working or volunteering for our Vulnerable Sector.

Delays are now being experienced for Police Information Checks regarding individuals who are involved or hope to be involved in the Vulnerable Sector, such as coaching, day cares, churches, senior's homes, and disabled group homes. Applications requiring this type of police

information checks are now scrutinized through a more rigorous screening process.

On July 19, 2010, the RCMP instituted enhancements to the Canadian Police Information Centre (CPIC) system, which broadened the scope for Vulnerable Screening potential matches.

It is important for the public to understand that under no circumstance does the notification of a “potential match” confirm that the applicant is a pardoned sex offender. In almost all cases, this “possible match” is ruled out by a fingerprint comparison.

All agencies requiring individuals to submit Vulnerable Sector requests for positions applying for positions of authority or trust relative to vulnerable persons must be aware of this change because these agencies will experience a similar increase and the delay will inevitably affect their operations.

When a Vulnerable Sector query results in a “potential match” the individuals affected must follow the following steps in order for their Vulnerable Sector checks to be completed in a timely manner:

- When contacted, attend the Police Service Headquarters (only) to have fingerprints taken
- The RCMP will waive their fee for processing fingerprints for volunteer purposes, if the applicant provides a letter on the organization’s letterhead that clearly states the applicants name and volunteer position they are applying for
- The RCMP charged \$25 for processing fingerprints that are required for student and employment purposes
- Complete and sign the RCMP consent form that enables the verification to be conducted

Police staff will forward the completed package to the RCMP in Ottawa. The RCMP has advised that once they receive the fingerprint package their process may take from 30 to 120 days due to potential high volume. For inquiries onto the status of your fingerprint results you can email the RCMP at civilnps@rcmp-grc.gc.ca or call 613-998-6362.

Police staff will contact the applicant once they receive the information back from the RCMP and provide documentation directly to the applicant.

CREDENTIAL RENEWAL FOR 2011

May I remind you that the time of credential renewal is upon us. Enclosed please find your Forms # 3 and Form # 4. This year the renewal fee is \$125.00 if sent in by January 31, 2011.

Please make all cheques/money orders payable to I. A. O. G. I. (Canada).

After February 1, there will be a late penalty of \$30.00 added to the \$125.00 = Total \$155.00.

For a minister 75 years of age and older your renewal fee is free. All you need to do is complete Forms # 3 and Form # 4, give us your birth date and we will gladly renew your credentials with no charge.

Please complete Form # 3. Forward Form # 3 with your cheque and Form # 4 to your licensing or ordaining pastor/church. The pastor/church will send the material directly to me.

We are pleased that a few have taken advantage of forms being offered on the web www.iaogcan.com and have renewed early.

Thank-you for your prompt attention to this important ministry matter.

KEEP US IN THE LOOP – WHEN YOU MAKE CHANGES

Please keep us in the loop with your new address, new e-mail, new phone number, and new cell phone number. This would be so much appreciated. Many times we get mail returned with address unknown and we would like to remedy this problem. We ask you to remember to let us know about your new contact information. It is my responsibility to know where the ministers we are governmental and spiritual covering for are located.

SAFETY MESSAGE FOR SMART PHONE USERS

We would like to educate members about the potential dangers in using smart phones. In recent years, major advancements in phone capabilities have dramatically changed how people communicate. Internet access by phone creates new opportunities for users to post information on websites such as Facebook, Twitter, Foursquare, and You Tube immediately from their location at that moment. While this is a convenience many enjoy, we would like to remind users that smart phones have a built-in feature called ‘geotagging’.

Geotagging is defined as the process of adding geographical identification to photographs, video, and websites. This data usually consists of latitude and longitude coordinates, though they can also include altitude, bearing, and place names.

Many people innocently take photos of their home, where they hang out, their friends' places etc., and then upload them up to the web. Most smart phones save geo-tag data and when a user uploads a photo, video, or text, geographical information is embedded and uploaded with it. The user has provided information about where they are, in most cases unknowingly. You could potentially be providing information about where you live, where you walk the dog, and where your kids go to school. There are individuals that may use this information to commit a crime.

Tips to Protect Yourself

- Check the instruction manual of your smart phone. Learn how it works.
- Consider turning off geotagging in your smart phone.
- Teach your children about geotagging.
- Spread the word. Educate people you know about the risks.

You don't need to be afraid of going online, just be careful and consider what you are sharing with the world. Remember: the internet never forgets. Just because you deleted something online, it can almost always be retrieved.

REPORT ABOUT PAKISTAN

Having just returned in September from a 6 week tour of Pakistan the Lord blessed and we wish to report. We now have a registered church in Pakistan called Harvest Church International Ministries Pakistan (HCIMP). We have ordained a minister to oversee the operation and expansion of HCIMP through Harvest Church Prescott Ontario. While in Pakistan I ministered in many churches, open air services and roof top meetings. Denominational barriers were no problem. Churches consisted of Pentecostal, (various denominations), Presbyterian, UPC, and many evangelicals.

We have a recorded count of 554 salvations (in Christian churches plus 3 Muslims). Testimonies were heard of many healings from cancer, kidneys, marriage reconciliations, instant pain relief, headaches, stomach and arthritis & rheumatism.

One young lady was given a report that she had an inoperable goiter. Doctors said she would have to take medication. The medication would eventually destroy her system and she would die. She stood on the Word of God and is now totally healed. All glory goes to the power of Jesus Christ.

We were able to purchase sewing machines to start a sewing center to give women some skills other than brick kiln or hard labour.

We were able to minister in villages where we also supplied necessities like rice, flour, sugar, olive oil etc to the real needy.

We were able to supply speakers and mics for a sound system in the gypsy area.

We were also able to help a young Pastor obtain a building (rent) to start his ministry.
We were also able to give to the victims of the flooded area through Jesus is a Live Ministry

Our goal is to raise funds to set a family free (\$3500 USD) from bond labour to brick kiln masters, who can do as they please to families. They can sell them, split families up and rape their women. Once a family is indebted to the brick kiln masters they are at their mercy. We have better utility sheds than they do houses. The story is too long to mention here.

GRANDVIEW CHAPEL, DAWSON CREEK, B.C.

Grandview Chapel in Dawson Creek, BC dates back about sixty years. It has been the centre of frequent and significant outpourings of the Holy Spirit during that period of time. However, in recent years the church has faced challenges that have resulted in a decline in their membership and attendance. When I served as the Northern British Columbia Regional Secretary, I was invited to give oversight to Grandview Chapel. In the summer of 2006, their pastor, Harold Ferguson resigned, and they were not in a position to call a new pastor. For a short period of time two lay leaders were appointed to give interim leadership to the congregation. In April, 2007 one of those lay leaders, Rob Nock was chosen to give pastoral leadership to Grandview Chapel. Pastor Rob was ordained in September, 2007 and continued to give pastoral leadership until July, 2010.

In June, 2010 Tony Vigar became the newly selected pastor of Grandview Chapel. Pastor Tony, and his wife Beverly along with their three children Kaden, Jasmine, and Levi moved to Dawson Creek, BC as of August 1, 2010 to assume pastoral responsibilities. Tony and Beverly both grew up in Westside Family Fellowship and graduated from Westside Academy in Prince George, BC. Tony began working on his Bachelor of Arts degree at Elim Bible Institute in Lima, New York, and completed it through Global University. Most recently he received his Master's Degree in Counselling from Providence Seminary in Manitoba.

The Leadership Team of Grandview Chapel is composed of point man, Tony Vigar, assisted by Rob Nock, and supported by elders Vern Haney, Lee Bowd, and Tom Hall. One of the great

concerns of this Leadership Team is for the spiritual health of the Body of Christ in the city and region of Dawson Creek, British Columbia. However, we all know that "prayer is the key, and faith unlocks the door!" So there is an urgency that the fellow members of the Independent Assemblies of God, Canada join the small group of believers at Grandview Chapel in prayer for a unifying of the Body of Christ in Dawson Creek. REFORMING HIS BODY THE CHURCH

In recent months the Lord has been issuing a sense of urgency in the area of preparation of His Church for the coming Reformation that is going to take place. In early Fall of 2003, I heard Him say this, "Many of my ministers grow weary with Me as they continue to seek Me and ask Me to send revival and I have yet to send revival to my Body the Church. I do not send revival because My desire is to send reformation. Revivals come and go, but when I bring reformation to My House it is lasting and stays."

In the last couple of years there has been confirmation of this word in several areas of the prophetic as I have heard the release of this same word. In order for Him to bring reformation, He must prepare His Body to receive it and move into it. He has given to us three areas that He wants to move in as He works in this time of preparation. I will write briefly about each one and understand they are equally important so the order in which they are written has nothing to do with priority.

First, is the area of marriage and how He is taking this, His first command to man, to its rightful place of authority in the Church. While meditating on Genesis chapter one in January 2008, there came a realization the authority over the earth was given to the man and the woman together after the Lord married them. The enemy is completely aware of this and is the reason we see such an attack on marriage and families. As I prayed about this the Lord said, "This command still stands," and confirmation came later in the year when I heard Dr. Chuck Pierce give a prophetic word during a service and in which he quoted this word for word.

The divorce rate for believers here in the States is as high as it is for nonbelievers and the rate for ministers is approaching thirty percent. How can we be separate, i.e. holy, when we look just like the world? There have been several divorce proceedings affecting some high profile ministries recently and one is shaking us here in the Messianic community in a ministry that is close to us. Our prayers are for this family and for understanding as well as for reconciliation. The world can ask, "When it comes to marriage, where is the advantage to having Jesus?" A couple months ago, I had a profound moment with Yahweh. You know, 'a moment of God's favor is worth a lifetime of my labor.' While laying in bed early before getting up to go to early

morning intercession at the church, I rolled over and put my arm over Denise to hold her for a moment before getting up. As I heard breathing that revealed to me she had fallen back to sleep, I began to vocally and softly praise our Father in Heaven, “Thank you Father for Your goodness and mercy and that out of Your goodness you designed and created marriage and said that ‘it was good’. And as in the days of Adam You looked down and saw that he had no ally (‘ally’ is a better translation from the ancient Hebrew than ‘helper’) and then You took from his womb a rib and formed woman. They would become one before You and in Your image you created them. And, in like manner You gave to me Denise to be my wife.” Immediately after saying “my wife,” I heard “She is MY daughter.”

I became silent and realized that I held in my arms the very daughter of Yahweh. Isn’t this just like God? I am praising Him for something so wonderful and of His creation yet it is temporal and He is reminding me that His thoughts toward Denise are eternal. Now, I have taken care to make sure that my earthly father-in-law knows I am taking care of her, but a new and greater emphasis came upon me as I have been given notice that I have a Heavenly Father-in-law.

To all of us in ministry, we need to be sure our priorities in order. When we get so busy ministering to others and the ministry at home gets put on the back burner, there is a heavy price to pay not only in our personal lives but in our relationship with the Lord. There is only one ministry greater than ministering to our families and that is ministry to Him. This is not to be confused for Him. There are times when we must go without our spouses and minister and I am not criticizing that, but we must first be sure we have ministered to our spouse and family at home before we leave. I must also interject here that the most precious time of ministry is when Denise and I are ministering together, and I might add the most powerful time.

The second area that Yeshua wants for His bride is the area of inner healing. I know we are all aware of this and many have been trained in inner healing and have received this ministry personally. I am one who has, but the Lord has been influencing me there is more to our souls that need healing and cleansing, even the long ago and hidden things.

While asking Him one day in intercession as to why not everyone gets their physical healing, He began to reveal to me weak areas with one being the wounds we carry that have yet to be dealt with. The Holy Spirit took me to John 14:30. He has been explaining to His disciples what He must do and they really didn’t have much of an understanding of what He was telling them. Then He says, “I will not speak much more with you, for the ruler of this world is coming and he has *nothing* (italics mine) in Me”. (NASB)

Denise and I are seeking the Lord for the hidden areas that need to be healed and delivered in us. There has been much written concerning this and we have gone through training with Path to Freedom Ministries some years ago. I have been through one session for my own healing, but recently there has been some fresh revelation concerning deliverance. The hard thing for us as ministers is sometimes to realize our need as we focus on the needs of others, and to lay down

ministry while we allow Yeshua to do the work He was sent to do and that is to set the captives free. Fortunately, grace allows us to minister and see the Spirit do a great work in ministry in spite of our need for healing, but think of how much more the Spirit could be set free to do when the enemy 'has nothing in us.'

This is a poem given in March 2006 by the Holy Spirit to a friend and prophet, Keith Lane:

Set Free

Release unto Me so that you can be free
Release unto Me so that others may be free
Release unto Me and the enemy must flee
Release unto Me and My people will shout with glee
Release unto Me so that *I may be free*
Matthew 11:28:30

The third area that the Lord is going to change is the spirit of anti-Semitism in His House. This will not do and has been an effective tool of the enemy to keep us from reaching full potential in the Kingdom. This has to do with simple mindedness like ministries doing 'crusades' in the Middle-East and elsewhere to outright denial of the place Israel has in the Kingdom through teaching Replacement Theology where the Church has replaced Israel as Yahweh's chosen and Dual Theology where Gentiles need Jesus and Jews don't because they have The Law. None of this was taught by Yeshua or the Apostles and can't be found in the New Testament.

I know that some ministries recognize Israel's rightful place, that we have a Jewish Messiah, and you will see gatherings where shofars are blown and some will wear tallits. We need to go deeper in our understanding from the Hebraic viewpoint and also to be the Church that makes the Jew jealous. Right now they think we are silly with thousands of denominations and plenty of infighting and we outright deny Yeshua's Jewish identity by ignoring some of what God commanded from the Hebrew Bible (The Old Testament). I recently was invited to a Shabbat service given by a loving couple who are exploring the Hebraic understandings of the Word and pork was served at the meal. It may seem like a minor thing, but a person who has been commanded by the same God that we claim to worship to not eat pork will view the Church as following a different god and this puts barriers up as we reach out to him or her. We must become more sensitive and sensible.

The way I read it, the Lord Yeshua (Jesus) is returning with the Host of Heaven to rule and He will not rule from Washington DC, Ottawa, London, New York, Rome or anywhere else except Jerusalem. He said he is not returning to Jerusalem until all there say, "Baruch habbah B'shem Adonai." Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Jewish evangelism is paramount to the return of Mashiach (Messiah) and the ministry that is in denial of this is reading a different bible and will be left out the end-time ministry. In fact they will be deceived, Matthew 24:5, and follow the Anti-Christ.

This is more than giving money to anyone who claims to help the Jews. Many millions of

Christian giving dollars are given to so-called groups that help Jews, but some of them are of the Anti-Christ spirit and believers are giving funds to those who teach that Yeshua is only the God of the Gentile and not the Savior of the world including the Jewish people. One of these that collects a lot of money from Christians, as their approach would lead you to believe they are believers too, actually makes their employees sign an affidavit that they will not even mention the name of Jesus or they will be released from employment. As part of Shalom Ministry, I can help guide with the giving to ministries that follow the Gospel as laid out in the New Testament in reaching the lost of Israel. My pastor friend, Dr. John Denson, says that for every Jewish person that he has been led to and comes into the Kingdom, the Lord brings four gentiles into the Kingdom along with the Jewish person.

As I close this writing, I am moved by the love of Yeshua to know that the Lord is patient and it will take time for us to come to the full realization of what He is about to do. His preparations are always complete and His awesome grace permeates everything He does. This is the time to be broken bread and poured out wine before Him and to allow the power of His love, mercy, and grace to work in us through His Spirit who counsels us in all truth. One morning in intercession, I was given a glimpse of His Bride. I saw beauty that I cannot describe in words and know that she will be without wrinkle or spot, and His return for her will be a joyous occasion that the earth and the heavens have never seen before.
